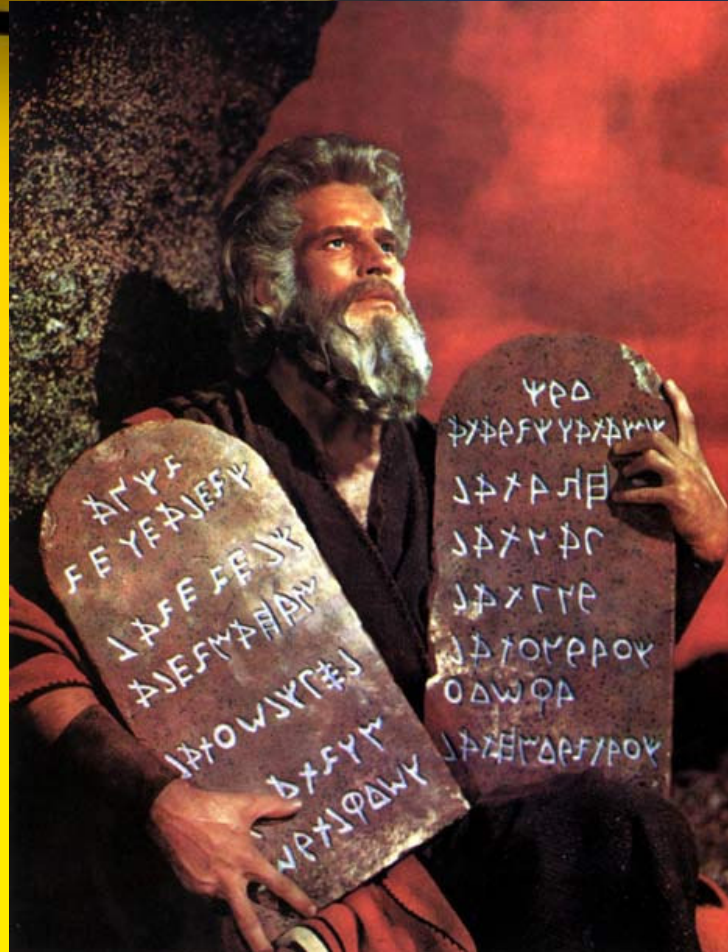

# I. SIGNIFICANT FACTS

- Name- This period was named after Moses
- Duration-1500 year span (Exodus 20-Acts 1)
- Background-promise to Abraham;the twelve tribes of Israel (Gal 3:16, 17)
- Importance-lessons learned from Moses, Joshua, Samson, Samuel, Saul, David and others (Roman 15:4; Heb. 11:32)

## II. THE LAW OF MOSES

- The Law was given to the Jews (Ex 20:1-17)
  - It wasn't given to all people (Ex 31:17,18; Nehemiah 9:13,14)
- Not given to fathers (Deut 5:1-3,12,15)
- One Law for Israel and the stranger (Ex 12:43-49)

## II. THE LAW OF MOSES

- The Law was a schoolmaster (Gal 3:19-29)
- The Law didn't provide remission of sins (Acts 13:38,39)
- The Law ended with the death of Christ (Heb.9:15-17; Col. 2:14-17)
- Serving the Law nullifies the cross (Gal. 2:21; 5:2-4)
